AYM is a cooperative program with parents of home-schooled students to educate students to love the Lord with all their minds through the study of mathematics.

Our goal is to provide support to your home school curriculum. We will provide pacing guides, offer once-a-week instruction (live and recorded), provide homework help via online math lab, assign weekly homework as concept practice, write quizzes and tests, and grade student performance on assessments. As a program designed to support parent-directed home education, parents will be involved in the daily work of the student. Parents will oversee daily completion of student assignments, grade daily assignments, and ensure the student correctly reworks the incorrectly answered problems. AYM teachers will meet with students each week, during which we will review problem areas and give introductions to the upcoming lessons. Students at AYM will faithfully attend class, bring completed assignments, be ready to ask questions on specific weak areas and seek help as needed. We believe that working cooperatively we – teachers, parents, & students - can help students excel academically in the courses AYM offers, as well as discovering the mathematical order to God's creativity in our world.

Payment information:

- Courses are \$55 per month for classes of two or more students, made in 9 payments beginning in August and ending in April. (No payment is made in May).
- Should only one student register for a course, the class will not be canceled, but price will be \$80.
- Payments will be made directly to each child's individual teacher, which means you will be writing more than one check if you have students in the classes of more than one teacher.
- The first payment will be due at orientation in August, all remaining payments will be due on the 15th of each month beginning in September with the final payment being due April 15th. There is NO payment due in May.
- Please make your payments on time. If your payment is late, **PLEASE AUTOMATICALLY** include a \$25 late fee per class per student to EACH teacher.

REGISTRATION FEE:

- Registration through May 31: \$45 per family
- Registration beginning June 1: \$65 per family
- Registration beginning August 1: \$80 per family

Your registration fee holds your child's place in the class and is *non-refundable*, unless, for some reason, your child is not placed, in which case you will be refunded the registration fee when that is determined.

We assign a priority number to your registration based on the date received and then deposit registration fees immediately upon receipt.
